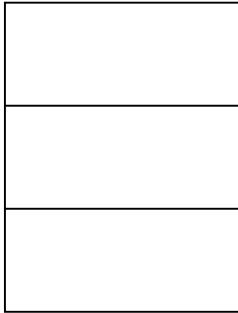


ODHA Little "Tooth Book"

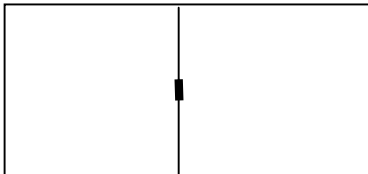
This booklet looks the best when printed on card stock, but not all printers can handle that. Regular paper is okay.

To make the booklet, print the "front side" and then turn over and print the "back side" on the same piece of paper.

Cut in three equal sections. Kinko's can cut a 4-inch stack for about \$2.00 per cut.



Place together and put one staple in the center - an "extended" stapler can reach.



Then fold in half. The pages should sequence like:

- Cover: Little "Tooth Book"
- Strong Teeth: Fluoride
- Clean Teeth
- Where is the Plaque Bacteria?
- Limit Sugar
- For Healthy Teeth for a Lifetime
- "Dental Basics" on Back
