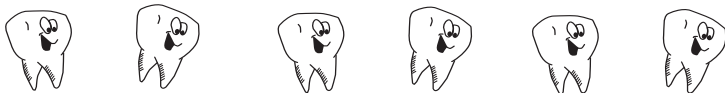
THE Give Kids a Smile
