Purpose: To define membership guidelines to the Oregon Dental Hygienists' Association.

Policy: A dental hygienist seeking membership will be accepted as a member of ODHA upon submission, receipt, acceptance and processing of the required registration application and fees. All memberships are for the specific and sole use of the registered individual from whom payment is made and are non-transferable.

Procedures:

Membership Categories

The membership categories for a Constituent (State) or Component (Local) Organization shall be consistent with ADHA's membership categories.

Membership Committee

The chair of the membership committee is elected by the members. The purpose of the committee is to recommend strategies for recruiting and retaining ODHA members, to assess member needs, to evaluate the services and benefits provided to members to ensure member needs are met, and to create member incentives and evaluate how to provide services that add value to members' professional lives.
